

Has your work schedule been impacted by COVID-19?

SFO's Business and Career Center (BCC) can help workers get access to benefits and resources they may need as a result of reduced work hours or layoffs related to COVID-19.

SFO's Business and Career Center can help you navigate financial resources and get access to emergency assistance such as food, clothing, and rent relief.

Workers should also consult with their individual employers and/or Unions about their sick leave policies and procedures and other resources that might be available.

Below are resources from the Employment Development Department (EDD). You can apply online for unemployment and other EDD work programs and benefits. SFO's Business and Career Center has computers available for use Monday-Friday from 8:30am to 4:30pm and by appointment. A staff member is onsite to help you with your application, if needed.

Resources from the Employment Development Department (EDD)

<p>Sick or Quarantined?</p>	<p>If you're unable to work due to having or being exposed to COVID-19 (certified by a medical professional), you can file a Disability Insurance (DI) claim. DI provides short-term benefit payments to eligible workers who have a full or partial loss of wages due to a non-work-related illness, injury, or pregnancy. Benefit amounts are approximately 60-70 percent of wages (depending on income) and range from \$50-\$1,300 a week.</p>
<p>Caregiving</p>	<p>If you're unable to work because you are caring for an ill or quarantined family member with COVID-19 (certified by a medical professional), you can file a Paid Family Leave (PFL) claim. PFL provides up to six weeks of benefit payments to eligible workers who have a full or partial loss of wages because they need time off work to care for a seriously ill family member. Benefit amounts are approximately 60-70 percent of wages (depending on income) and range from \$50-\$1,300 a week.</p>
<p>Reduced Work Hours</p>	<p>If your employer has reduced your hours or shut down operations due to COVID-19, you can file an Unemployment Insurance (UI) claim. UI provides partial wage replacement benefit payments to workers who lose their job or have their hours reduced, through no fault of their own. Workers who are temporarily unemployed due to COVID-19 and expected to return to work with their employer within a few weeks are not required to actively seek work each week. However, they must remain able and available and ready to work during their unemployment for each week of benefits claimed and meet all other eligibility criteria. Eligible individuals can receive benefits that range from \$40-\$450 per week.</p>
