Earn money.

Lend buses and vans –drivers, too– to other organizations on days or during hours you don't need them.

Save money.

Why buy new passenger vehicles when your organization can borrow them only when you need them?

Cities, agencies, and other organizations in San Mateo County are trying to do more with fewer resources. Peninsula Fleet Share, a new program sponsored by the San Mateo County Transit District, provides a tool for sharing passenger vehicles among cities and organizations in San Mateo County.

Register now. It's easy.

Register for Peninsula Fleet Share and gain access to a range of vehicle types owned by cities and organizations, available at reasonable rates. You can also advertise your own vehicles and rates, as well as rates for drivers, so others may borrow from your fleet. We'll walk you through it and make sure you have all of the information you need to be ready to lend or borrow vehicles.

Registering is free if you respond now. A one-time administrative fee of \$75 is required to register, but if you register by June 28, 2013 we'll waive the fee.

Lend an unused vehicle or borrow a vehicle to temporarily increase capacity of an existing fleet, offer a special outing for seniors, provide job training transportation, or transport community members to park and recreation programs.

Once you've registered, get on line.

When you register, you'll receive a password to use the Peninsula Fleet Share website, where you can post vehicles or browse vehicles shared by other cities or organizations.



Start lending or borrowing vehicles — and drivers, if you need them.

Once you've registered, we'll provide you with the information you need to lend or borrow vehicles.

With easy-to-use agreements and templates, after you find your match on-line, you can negotiate the details of the lending/borrowing arrangement. And we'll provide technical assistance and guidance if you need it.

We've done the hard work to make things easier for you.

Registered members are provided with information on insurance arrangements and risk management, a sample agreement for vehicle sharing, and guidelines for charging others to use your vehicles. Once you register, you'll enjoy access to an expanding database of potential partners, program marketing resources, and technical support from San Mateo County Transit District staff, consultants and attorneys.
